

Editorial

Dear readers,

This year, our international journal of maritime science and technology *Naše more* celebrates its 100th anniversary. The first issue of the journal *Naše more* was published in 1919. A short publishing period (only two years) was followed by a long interruption and it reappeared again in 1954. It has continually been published for 67 years now. It has been a very long and restless period. There are just a few specialized seafaring journals worldwide, published for such a long period and our publication may be considered to be both our maritime and cultural heritage.

We are happy to announce the International Conference - *Naše more* 2019, taking place in Dubrovnik, 17-18 October 2019. The Conference aims to bring together leading academic scientists, researchers, research scholars and practitioners to exchange and share their experiences and research results regarding all aspects of maritime science and technology. Authors are kindly encouraged to contribute to and help shape the conference through submissions and presentations of their research abstracts and papers. All submitted conference papers will be reviewed twice and published afterwards in conference proceedings. We are pleased to inform you that after the Conference (based on the decision made by the Scientific Committee and the Editor in Chief) the authors of the best presented papers will be invited to submit expanded and revised papers for further publication in journal *Naše more*. In the 2019 second issue the original scientific paper is written by the authors Muhamed Fočak, Subha Džafić and Damir Suljević titled *Electrolites and Heavy Metals in Coelomic Fluid of Sea Urchin, Arbacia lixula from Adriatic Sea: Biochemical Approach to Ecotoxicological Study*, Srećko Krile and Nikolai N. Maiorov titled *Work Analysis of Maritime Passenger Terminals for Particular Region Based on Circos Plot*.

The following paper is a preliminary communication written by the authors Dario Medić, Zvonimir Lušić and Rino Bošnjak titled *Comparative Analysis of the Maritime Venture Risk and the Cost of Averting a Fatality in the Republic of Croatia*. There are three scientific review articles. The first one is by the author Dejan Lovrinčević titled *The Development of a New Methodology for Automated Sounding Selection on Nautical Charts*, the second is authored by Leo Čampara, Merica Slišković and Gorana Jelić Mrčelić titled *Key Ballast Water Management Regulations With a View on Ballast Water Management Systems Type Approval Process* and the authors of the third are Marija Crnčević, Ana Bratoš Cetinić, Marijana Pećarević, Željka Rajković and Dominik Mihaljević titled *The Contribution of Scientific and Historical Data to the Conservation and Management of the Island of Lokrum Marine Area*.

As you know, the papers published in our journal are indexed in various citation databases. We have been a Scopus indexed journal for over 15 years now, while recently our journal entered a WoS Core Collection (ESCI) base. Our main goal is to be accepted for inclusion in the Science Citation Index Expanded (SCI-E), which depends solely on the quality of the published articles. Therefore, authors are invited to help us accomplish that goal by striving to improve the quality of their articles with the original and concise subject matter elaborated in their papers.

Besides our publisher, The University of Dubrovnik, the journal is considerably supported by The Ministry of Science, Education and Sport of the Republic of Croatia. In addition to the support provided by The Ministry and our Editor, our sponsors are especially important, Atlantska plovidba being our longest continuous sponsor. Recently, the Society of Friends of Dubrovnik Antiques, Tourist Board of the City of Dubrovnik, Dubrovnik-Neretva County, Dubrovnik Airport and others have become our partners.

Ove godine naš međunarodni znanstveni časopis o pomorstvu i tehnologiji slavi svoju stotu godišnjicu od utemeljenja. Prvi je broj časopisa „*Naše more*“ bio objavljen 1919. godine.
